



# DuPage County Health Department Immunization Clinics

## Who Can Attend?

Residents of DuPage County may attend. Childhood immunizations are available for children who have no insurance, who have insurance that does not cover immunizations, or are Medicaid/AllKids recipients.

A Parent or Legal Guardian must accompany any child under the age of 18.

A fee of \$15.00 is requested per immunization.

Adult immunizations are available (over 19 years of age). Fees vary and are subject to change.

## How Do I Get Immunized?

Attend any of our Immunization Clinics. Times and locations are listed below.

Bring all records of previous immunizations given by a doctor or clinic. Records should include any tetanus immunizations received in a hospital emergency room. Know the weight of the person being immunized.

The DuPage County Health Department provides immunizations at clinics located at the Public Health Centers on a walk-in basis. No appointments are necessary.
